All of the services listed are free to Volunteers.

IMMUNIZATIONS

- All new Volunteers must provide proof of immunity to the following:
 - Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)*
 - Varicella (Chicken Pox)*
 - Hepatitis-B (for clinical Volunteers with patient contact)*
 - *If proof cannot be provided, the OH nurse will need to draw the Volunteer's blood for the lab to determine immunity:
 - This can be done at the time of PPD placement, during our Monday Walk-In Clinics, or an appointment must be scheduled.
 - *If it is determined that the Volunteer is not immune to these diseases, the Volunteer will be notified and the vaccinations will be offered <u>free of charge</u>.
 - Vaccines will be administered during our Monday Walk-In Clinics, or an appointment must be scheduled.
- ➤ Annual Influenza Vaccinations Mandatory October March

TB SCREENING PROCEDURES

- > Two-Step TB Testing
 - New Volunteers who cannot provide proof of a negative PPD within the past 12 months will be given a two-step PPD (the test will be administered and read twice within a 2 week period)
 - Walk-In Clinics for TB placements and readings are held on Mondays from 8:00am-11:30am and 1:30pm-3:30pm. If Mondays are not convenient for you, please contact the Occupational Health Office to schedule an appointment at 443-643-3428.
 - You must return to the Occupational Health Office 2-3 days (48-72 hours) after the PPD is administered for the nurse to read the result:
 - ★ This is done at quarter to the hour (<u>except between 12-1pm</u>) and takes only a couple of minutes 7:45 8:45 9:45 10:45 11:45 1:45 2:45 3:45 (except Mondays at 3:30)
 - If the two-step PPD is required, the second PPD test will be administered at least <u>1 week</u> after the initial PPD testing by appointment or Monday Walk-In Clinic.
 - If you fail to return for your second PPD, you will not be allowed to work until it is completed.

Please don't forget to call Occupational Health to schedule your 2nd Step PPD in one week!
