While the Dean and Executive Committee retain control over the operations of the School, the faculty retains the full authority for decisions related to the content and design of academic program curricula, academic policies and procedures, admissions standards and requirements, grading standards, progression and advancement standards, and educational program outcomes. The meetings have an agenda that is distributed in advance that typically consists of faculty, appointment, promotion and tenure items, informational items relevant to faculty and often a research presentation.
